



## Four Year Ph.D. Fellowships in Mechanical Engineering

The University of Arkansas in Fayetteville has Ph.D. Fellowships available to Department of Mechanical Engineering students. Two types of fellowships are available with the following financial package, eligibility requirements, and deadline:

*Distinguished Doctoral Fellowship:*

\$3,150 Monthly Stipend (\$37,800 per year)

Tuition Waiver

Up to \$1,000 Annual Allowance to Attend One Conference as Presenter

U.S. Citizen and Permanent Residents

3.85 GPA Minimum

1,300 GRE Verbal + Quantitative Minimum

5.5 GRE Analytical Writing Minimum

B.S. or M.S. in Mechanical Engineering, or equivalent.

Deadline: February 1<sup>st</sup> (for fall enrollment)

*Distinguished Academy Fellowship:*

\$2,300 Monthly Stipend (\$27,600 per year)

Tuition Waiver

Up to \$1,000 Annual Allowance to Attend One Conference as Presenter

Foreign Students Eligible

3.65 GPA Normally

1,200 GRE Verbal + Quantitative Normally

5.0 GRE Analytical Writing Normally

B.S. or M.S. in Mechanical Engineering, or equivalent.

Deadline: Rolling (for fall, spring, and summer enrollment)
