PREMEDICAL OPTION AGREEMENT**

The Premedical option in Mechanical Engineering is designed for students planning to attend medical school after graduation. Completing this curriculum will satisfy most medical schools' minimum course admission criteria. The BSME premedical option requires that students take and complete the following courses in lieu of the 12 hours of technical-science elective courses:

BIOL 1543 / 1541L Principles of Biology
MBIO 2013 / 2011L General Microbiology
CHEM3603 / 3601L Organic Chemistry
CHEM3613 / 3611L Organic Chemistry II

In addition to course work, most medical schools require other activities and tests such as volunteer work in a medical facility and a satisfactory score on the MCAT test. Therefore, students electing the premedical option are advised to contact the U of A premedical advisor in their freshman year.
